## ABORIGINAL LITERACY FOUNDATION, VICTORIA

The ALF targets Indigenous young people between the ages of 6-17 in regional Victoria who are experiencing primary risk factors such as truancy, poor academic performance and low level literacy and numeracy skills.

As one in five Indigenous young people can't read or write, these services are invaluable and include weekly literacy tutoring of 250 high risk indigenous youth and literacy support kits and books to 10,000 children in remote and rural communities.

The \$37,000 donation is for the purchase and fit out of a mini-van which will be used as a Mobile Literacy Classroom for regional Victoria and southern NSW to help improve the literacy levels of indigenous students.
