Cerebral Palsy Tasmania (CPT) was established in 1963 and provides services to Tasmanians living with Cerebral Palsy and related disabilities as well as their families and carers.

The organisation's services include transport to supported employment for up to 20 adults and transport to and from school for 80 children – all relying on just the one bus driven by volunteer drivers.

The \$30,000 donation will be used to purchase a second bus with an electric hoist, which will accommodate three passengers and three wheelchairs. This will allow the CPT to provide more transport to supported employment and also extend their service to include social outings and other activities.
