## KEVIN HEINZ GARDEN CENTRE, VICTORIA

The KHGC was established by the late Kevin Heinze to provide children with disabilities or disadvantage a range of activities in a therapeutic environment. The centre provides recreational horticultural therapy to clients from over 40 community groups.

All program participants have a disability, are frail aged or have some other significant disadvantage and there are 10 trainees with a disability. Everyone needs to find their own transport as the centre has no vehicle.

The \$42,000 donation will be used to purchase a twin-cab utility to take trainees to work experience, transport the frail aged to and from the centre and for picking up and delivering plants.
