## SAILABILITY, NSW

Sailability NSW provides people with a disability the opportunity to participate in sailing and boating at recreational and competitive levels and is 100% run by volunteers.

Without sponsorship NSW female duo, Ame Barnbrook and Lindsay Mason would be unable to compete in the SKUD18 class in the 2011 World Championships in Weymouth UK, a selection event for the 2012 Paralympic Games in London.

The \$17,000 donation to Sailability NSW will be used to adapt the SKUD18's seating and controls for 22 year old Ame, who was born without arms. It will also cover the expenses of shipping the boat to the UK and help these girls in their goal to represent Australia.
