Spina bifida is the incomplete formation of the spine and spinal cord that occurs during the first month of a baby's development resulting a range of permanent physical and intellectual disabilities.

The SPFV was founded more than 10 years ago by a group of parents, physiotherapists and doctors. Along with other services, the SPFV raises funds to run summer and winter camps, which are normally impossible for sufferers due to their medical condition.

The \$30,000 donation will be used to hold a 2011 winter camp and a 2012 summer camp for up to 40 children and their families offering them the opportunity to socialise in a safe, medically supervised environment.
